The American Association of Automatic Door Manufacturers is a trade association of manufacturers of automatic pedestrian door systems. It was founded in 1994 to promote safety in the manufacture and operation of automatic doors throughout the industry.

All AAADM members manufacture their automatic door systems and/or components in substantial compliance with the *American National Standard for Power Operated Pedestrian Doors*, ANSI/BHMA A156.10, *American National Standard for Power Assist And Low Energy Power Operated Doors*, ANSI/BHMA A156.19, *American National Standard for Power and Manual Operated Revolving Pedestrian Doors*, ANSI/BHMA A156.27, and *American National Standard for Low Energy Power Operated Sliding and Folding Doors*, ANSI/BHMA A156.38. These national consensus standards define and govern requirements for pedestrian automatic door systems.

AAADM provides a Certification Training Program for installers and service technicians in the interest of improving and promoting safety in the industry. AAADM recommends annual inspections, conducted by an AAADM Certified Inspector, be performed on every automatic pedestrian door system. The AAADM Certified Inspectors provide maintenance, repair, and annual inspections of automatic door systems and help promote customer awareness and product safety.
